Audition time slots have been extended from 8 to 9 minutes in length as of Fall 2017 to allow auditions to run closer to on time. (All time constraints in the audition are still the same.) The order of scales & triads has changed beginning Fall 2017. The scales will now go left to right. Remember to scroll to the bottom of the aschoir.com home page and "like" us on Facebook and Twitter! Postmark deadline is September 13th! Please remind your students that cell phones are not allowed in the audition rooms during auditions. Audition registration fee is \$20 per student.
