

All-State Choir Audition Procedures for Students

- Plan to dress up for your audition. Students should plan on wearing a or dress slacks and a button up/collared shirt. Please make sure your clothes are modest. Please do not wear any attire that indicates what school you attend.
 - You **MUST** have an original score for the judge that is in the same key as your arrangement. The judge will not hear you if your music is copied.
 - Bring a bottle of water with you to your audition.
 - Arrive 30-45 minutes prior to your audition time.
 - When you arrive, check in at the information desk and get your blue audition card. Double check the spelling of your name and that your voice part is accurate. If there is a problem, please have your director contact the Site Governor to make the appropriate changes (no changes will be made unless your director is present).
 - Familiarize yourself with the layout of the audition site, locating the warm-up rooms, your judging room and the restrooms.
 - Warm-up rooms are shared and public. They should be used to vocalize and/or run-through your audition piece with your accompanist. Please be considerate of others when sharing this space.
 - Arrive at the check-in table/door monitor 10 minutes prior to your scheduled time. You may be asked to go early, or the schedule can sometimes be delayed because of accompanist availability. Don't worry if you must let someone go in front of you because your accompanist is playing for another audition. Make sure you go into the correct judge's room.
 - Auditions are private and **NO ONE** may listen through the door to an audition. It is unethical to share information about the audition with other auditioning students.
 - Cell phones are not allowed in the audition room. If a judge sees a phone during auditions, the student will be disqualified. Feel free to leave your phone with the door monitor.
 - If an issue arises during your audition, notify your director and one of the Site Governors *immediately* after your audition. We cannot remedy the situation once you have left the building. This is *your* responsibility!
 - Students who are not auditioning or have already auditioned must wait in designated areas and not remain by the judging rooms. It is expected that students are quiet while waiting to audition.
 - Relax, breathe, and congratulate yourself on all the hard work you have put into preparing for your audition. It will make you a better singer and the audition is intended to be a positive learning experience.
 - Audition results will be available in mid November.
